Granby Ranch is thrilled to be directly engaged with the East and West Grand School Districts relative to the development of special and exclusive programs which allow for affordable access to skiing and riding and learn-to-ski/ride programs for students, faculty and staff of East & West Grand County School Districts.

The Grand School Season Pass (GSSP)

Granby Ranch is glad to provide the Grand County School District community with specially discounted season passes for the 2025/26 winter season. These discounts apply to all students enrolled in the East and West Grand School Districts, all full-time and part-time teachers and all administrative staff working within the East and West Grand School Districts.

This is only offered for a limited time starting now through 12/20/2025.

Special pricing and subsequent conditions/restrictions apply as follows:

The Grand School Season Pass (GSSP)

Ages 6-12: Unlimited Junior Student \$249

Ages 13-18: Unlimited Teen Student \$319

Ages 19-75: Unlimited Teacher/Staff \$419

How to Purchase a Student/Teacher GSSP:

- a. The GSSP can be purchased at the link you were emailed.
 - **All sales are non-refundable and non-transferable.**
- b. Granby Ranch has moved to RFID technology for lift access. There will be a fee of \$5.00 for the cost of the pass/RFID card. This pass is re-usable each year, if lost additional passes are \$5.00.
- c. The administrative staff at East and West Grand School Districts will provide a complete list of all eligible participants in the GSSP program and will provide ongoing notifications of changes/modifications to the list of those eligible. Pass privileges will be terminated upon any student expulsion or staff/teacher departure from the East and West Grand School District.
- d. The Unrestricted Passes have no blackout dates.
- e. **Additional season pass perks are NOT included in the GSSP.**
- f. Valid documentation must be provided upon season pass pick up. We will accept a 25/26 Staff ID or 25/26 Student ID.

Free Fridays & Learn to Ski/Ride

FREE SKI/RIDE FRIDAYS WILL BEGIN ON 12/5/2025

Granby Ranch will provide complimentary lift tickets, ski/snowboard rentals and learn-to-ski (Level 1) ski/ride instruction on specified Fridays throughout the 2025/26 season. This program is available to all students enrolled in the East and West Grand School Districts, all full and part-time teachers and all administrative staff working within the East and West Grand School Districts.

Free Friday Pass

Lift access is free, without any restrictions, every Friday. Granby Ranch has moved to RFID technology for lift access. This ticket/RFID card is re-usable and will be active each Friday of the 2025-26 Winter Season. Each ticket/RFID card issued will cost \$5.00, BE SURE TO KEEP your first one, it's good all season long!

A signed release of liability by a parent or legal guardian must be completed for all children aged 17 & under.

You can purchase your Free Friday pass at the link you were emailed.

The Free Friday pass must be picked up at the ticket window and a **2025/26 Student/Employee ID must be presented at time of pick up.**

For your convenience, your Free Friday pass will be active every Friday, so no need to go to the Ticket Office each Friday you visit.

The Free Friday pass is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Free Fridays – Ski & Snowboard Rentals

The complimentary ski & snowboard rentals take place on specified Fridays. You must check in the Ticket Office to get a free rental loaded onto your RFID card every time you want to rent.

Free Fridays- Learn to Ski & Snowboard Lessons

The complimentary ski and snowboard lessons take place on non-holiday Fridays from 1:00-3:30pm. Parents or legal guardians must accompany their children to check in/pick up and remain on-site during the entire lesson.

Each student can receive up to a maximum of 3 lessons during this season. These students can only be first-timers or beginner skiers.

This program is first come first served. You can sign up in person beginning at 10am each Friday outside of blackout dates.

There will be a maximum of 15 students per session.

Lift passes are required to participate in lessons.

Please note: Snowboard Lessons are for ages 6+.
